
29% took the March COVID-19 Business Impact Survey

This survey was created to give the Acadiana region information to inform and guide the actions of organizations working to support businesses across Acadiana. The results provide insight into how many businesses are responding right now but are only representative of survey respondents. All responses were voluntary.

High-level findings from the survey


- The top three impact areas remain the same as the March survey:
 - Watching spending closely
 - Canceling events and purchase orders
 - Adjusting work schedules and locations
- Approximately 90% of businesses reported the expectation that their revenue will be down significantly or down slightly in both the March and April surveys
- About half of responding businesses remain open to some degree
- There continues to be a high level of uncertainty on workforce issues, with over half of responding businesses indicating they have/may reduce staff or are unsure if they can continue to keep current staffing levels
- More than half of businesses reported uncertainty when estimating how long their business will continue to survive
- The Paycheck Protection Program and Economic Injury Disaster Loan are the most popular assistance programs, but many businesses indicated roadblocks to applying for these programs

How is your business being impacted by COVID-19?



What is your current operating status?



Has your business reduced operational hours, shifts, work days, or wages?






Have you already – or do you expect to – reduce staff or lay off employees as a result of impact from COVID-19?



If yes, please estimate the number who have been or may be impacted by layoffs




How is your business adjusting operations?

How long can your business weather the impact from COVID-19?




Frequently mentioned in "other" (March):


