Statewide Constitutional Amendments

Constitutional Amendment No. 1

Allow lawmakers to consider overriding a gubernatorial veto without calling a separate veto session if they are already in a legislative session and clarify details about the deadlines for a governor to veto bills

Yes 61%

No 27%

Constitutional Amendment No. 2

Remove six inactive funds from the Louisiana Constitution and transfer any remaining balances in those funds to the state general fund

Yes 55%

No 45%

Constitutional Amendment No. 3

Authorize a parish governing authority to provide an additional ad valorem property tax exemption of up to \$25,000 to police, firefighters, and certain other first responders who live within the parish

Yes 53%

No 47%

Constitutional Amendment No. 4

Establish stricter limits on the circumstances under which the Legislature may make withdrawals from the Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund, including limiting the dollar amount of such withdrawals to \$250 million, and allow the Legislature to modify conditions for accessing monies in the Fund, subject to a two-thirds vote

Yes 44%

No 56%
