Statewide Constitutional Amendments

Constitutional Amendment No. 1

Prohibit foreign government or nongovernmental funds or resources from being used to conduct elections in Louisiana, unless authorized by the Secretary of State

Yes 73%

No 27%

Constitutional Amendment No. 2

Provide that freedom of worship in churches or other places of worship is a fundamental right worthy of the highest order of protection

Yes 79%

No 21%

Constitutional Amendment No. 3

Require a minimum of 25% of nonrecurring state revenue to be directed to payments on the unfunded accrued liability (UAL) of the state retirement systems

Yes 56%

No 44%

Constitutional Amendment No. 4

Deny property tax exemptions to nonprofit corporations or associations that own residential property in such a state of disrepair that it endangers public health or safety

Yes 66%

No 34%
